

Room For Doubt Apologetics Scholarship - LCU Undergraduate Application -

The Room For Doubt grant program (www.roomfordoubt.com) at Lincoln Christian University offers scholarship assistance to encourage students to pursue an undergraduate *minor* in apologetics and take courses in apologetics. Broadly speaking, apologetics is the effort to present a clear and convincing case for the Christian faith, especially in light of alternative philosophies and religions.

(1) Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov.

(2) Applicants must submit this application form *each semester* to be considered for a scholarship. Scholarships range from \$500-\$750 *per approved course*. Apologetics *minors* may receive \$750 *per approved course* (up to two per semester). *Non-apologetics* minors may receive \$500 *per approved course* (one per semester). These are *tuition-only* scholarships and are applied to a student's financial account. If a student receives a scholarship for a course and does not pass the course, the scholarship will be retracted, and the amount of the scholarship will be added back to the student's account.

Earlier applications receive priority consideration. Applications are accepted as follows:

For Fall Semester: From March 1 up until 7 days before the start of classes.

For Spring Semester: From October 1 up until 7 days before the start of classes.

Scholarship awards are determined by Room For Doubt staff in consultation with the LCU Financial Aid Office and are based on a variety of considerations:

- The availability of Room For Doubt funds.
- Financial need.
- Church or Christian ministry involvement.
- Academic merit (e.g. high school record, college GPA).
- The level of personal interest in Christian apologetics.
- The desire to incorporate apologetics in ministry (e.g. teaching in church, youth groups, camps, small groups).
- Priority is given to those who are pursuing an undergraduate minor in apologetics.
- Applicants may be asked to provide references and/or do an interview (in person, by phone, or by video call).
